This packet includes information that may help you determine what class to choose as well as the registration form needed. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the preschool office during the morning hours @ (812) 299-3336 or the director's cell @ (812) 236-6951.

Students who are currently enrolled and their siblings will be able to register on MONDAY, FEBRUARY 23rd and anytime thereafter. Please hand your registration form and registration payment; including \$10 for a TPS tote bag (returning students may choose to use last year's bag) to us in the drop-off line for school. We will collect the registration envelopes in the order in which we receive them. If your child does not attend school on Mondays, you may join our Monday drop-off line to hand us your registration. If you need to turn it in at another time, just ring the doorbell beside the preschool office door and we can get it from you.

New students will be able to register on Wednesday, February 25th. Please share this date with any new family who may be interested in registering.

TO REGISTER:

Please complete BOTH sides of the registration form and turn it in with your registration payment (checks made out to Temple Preschool). If you need a tote bag (all new students do) please include that \$10 payment in your total as well. The preschool office door is located on the south end of United Methodist Temple and it is the door on the left. The church office is open Tues. & Thurs. 9:30 to 3:30 and you can also drop off registrations there. Please use the door on the back of the church. You can always mail it as well, but don't delay, some classes may fill quickly.

When enrolling your child for preschool classes, your child's age on August 1, 2026, should determine which class he/she will be in. Some families may choose to remain in a class if they feel their child will benefit from another year there.

The class you choose will have equal monthly tuition charges no matter the number of class sessions within the month. Holidays often affect the schedule. The cost is prorated.

The one-time registration fee (which includes registration, supply, and insurance fees) is due with your registration (checks made out to Temple Preschool). The registration totals are listed below with the information for each class. *No refunds will be offered for withdrawals.*

At TPS we ALL use a tote bag to avoid all of the many zippers and pockets that come with backpacks! Please mark on the registration form whether or not you need a new tote bag. If you do, please include the \$10 with your registration payment.

- All Classes include Weekly Music Class and a Weekly Bible Time.
- There will be a prayer before eating snack and lunch.
- Classes also typically visit monthly with the pastor for Time with Pastor.

CLASSES OFFERED:

Two years old by August 1, 2026

Two-year old Class (2 days – T/TH)

- Teacher: Mrs. Toni Callahan (Miss Toni)
- 9-11:30 a.m.
- 9 equal payments of \$120.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$120.00 registration fee due @ registration
- \$35 annual snack fee due @ visitation day
- Do NOT need to be potty trained
- Monthly color, shape, theme, rhyme, and concepts with curriculum

Two-year old Class (Flexible Schedule M/W/F)

- Teacher: Mrs. Toni Callahan (Miss Toni)
- 9-11:30 a.m.
- You may choose 1, 2, or 3 mornings per week for this class.
One morning per week students must also be registered in the T/Th 2s Class as we don't feel like one morning per week alone will offer the consistency to successfully become accustomed to preschool.
- 9 equal payments due @ beginning of each month: 1 morning: \$60 per month, 2 mornings: \$120 per month, or 3 mornings: \$155 per month
- \$60 registration fee (if registering for 1 morning) due @ registration
\$120 registration fee (if registering for 2 mornings) due @ registration
\$155 registration fee (if registering for 3 mornings) due @ registration.
- Annual snack fee due @ visitation day: \$20 (1 day), \$35 (2 days), or \$45 (3 days)
- Do NOT need to be potty trained
- Monthly color, shape, theme, rhyme, and concepts with curriculum
In the past we have had a 3-year-old who is NOT yet potty trained in this group.

Three years old by August 1, 2026

Three-year-old Classes (2 days - T/TH)

- Teachers: Mrs. Wesley Thomson
- 9-11:30 a.m.
- 9 equal payments of \$120.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$120.00 registration fee due @ registration
- MUST BE POTTY TRAINED
- 11:1 student / teacher ratio with part-time assistant
- \$35 annual snack fee due @ visitation day

Three-year-old Class (3 days – M/W/F)

- Teacher: Mrs. Wesley Thomson or Mrs. Audrey Myers
- 9-11:30 a.m.
- 9 equal payments of \$145.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$145.00 registration fee due @ registration
- MUST BE POTTY TRAINED
- 11:1 student / teacher ratio with part-time assistant
- \$45 annual snack fee due @ visitation day

All three-year-old classes work to prepare students for PreK with practice with colors, shapes, numbers, letters, cutting, holding pencils and many concepts with curriculum. Socialization skills are emphasized.

****If you want to attend five days a week you can sign up for both classes. ****

Three-year-old students can extend their day until 12:30 pm with Lunch Bunch or 2pm by adding Afternoon Friends See Afternoon Program Information after PreK Information.

PreK Classes – Four years old by August 1, 2026

Pre-Kindergarten Class – Extended Day – (3 Day Class M/W/F)

- Teacher: Mrs. Heather Nees
- 9 to 2 p.m. (Child brings lunch each day)
- 9 equal payments of \$175.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$175.00 registration fee due @ registration
- \$45 annual snack fee due @ visitation day

Pre-Kindergarten Classes – Extended Day – (3 Day Class T/W/TH)

- Teachers: Mrs. Brooke Thomas –OR– Mrs. Beth Creasey
- 9 to 2 p.m. (Child brings lunch each day)
- 9 equal payments of \$175.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$175.00 registration fee due @ registration
- \$45 annual snack fee due @ visitation day

All Pre-K Classes:

- 12:1 student / teacher ratio with part-time assistants
- MANY concepts with curriculum. Each PreK teacher has different education methods.
- All classes are working toward the same goal to prepare your child for kindergarten and to be good Christian citizens.

Pre-K Morning Enrichment Class on M/F Mornings (to add to any T/W/Th PreK)

- Teacher: Mrs. Thomas
- 9-11:30 a.m.
- 9 equal payments of \$95.00 due @ beginning of each month
- \$95.00 registration fee due @ registration
- 12:1 student / teacher ratio with part-time assistants
- \$20 annual snack fee due @ visitation day
- This class is for PreK students who want to extend their week and the subjects they study. If students want to extend their day on Monday and Friday, they can use Lunch Bunch (12:30 dismissal) or Afternoon Friends (2:00 dismissal).

AFTERNOON PROGRAMS:

Lunch Bunch (M/T/W/TH/F – 11:30 to 12:30 PM)

- No sign-up needed
- Bring lunch and \$3 to school any day once your little one is ready to extend their day.

Afternoon Friends (M/T/W/TH/F – 11:30 to 2PM)

- Teachers: Miss Toni / Mrs. Loffredo / Other teachers as needed
- 11:30-2 p.m.
- For 2-year-old and 3-year-old students T/W/Th and all ages on M/F.
- This class allows students to extend their day at school after their morning class.
- Do NOT need to be potty trained
- You may choose 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 afternoons per week for this class.
- 9 equal payments due @ beginning of each month: 1 afternoon: \$40 per month, 2 afternoons: \$80 /month, 3 afternoons: \$120 /month, 4 afternoons: \$140/ month, 5 afternoons: \$155/month
- *Since you are enrolled in a morning class in addition to Afternoon Friends, you will NOT pay an Afternoon Friends registration fee.*
- 12:2 student / teacher ratio
- Students bring lunch from home to eat during this class.
- Following lunch there is a supervised free time with emphasis on socialization. There may be a story, games, or a craft; however, this class does not follow a curriculum such as in the morning preschool classes. We do not have a nap time.
- If your child is enrolled in Afternoon Friends with a standing reservation, you would pay the tuition on a monthly basis and his/her spot would always be reserved. If your child is absent, you would still be responsible for the same monthly payment.
- If there are Afternoon Friends spots available after the school year begins you may reach out to see if there is an opening and sign up just for that one “drop-in” day. At that time, you would send your child’s lunch plus \$10 on that day.
- Again, this “drop-in” is only available if we have openings.
